Basics of umpiring	Free	1 hour	Duties of an umpire, Spirit of cricket, common methods of dismissal, dangerous bowling, signals, breaking the wicket	For the complete beginner wanting some knowledge of the Laws, the casual "10 over" umpire, or the parent helping out in junior cricket
Stage 1 face-to-face	£30.00	1 day or 4 evenings	As above, ground weather and light, pre-match duties, scoring runs, extras, batsman's ground, more on dismissals	For the non-independent recreational umpire or coaches regularly umpiring junior cricket or those aspiring to act as an independent umpire
Stage 1 online	Free	"In your own time"	As above but entirely self-taught through the online modules	As above
Stage 2 face-to-face	£30 but £10 if booked with Stage 1 face-to-face	1 day or 4 evenings	Interaction with colleague, Match regulations exercises, remaining methods of dismissal, runners, substitutes, Penalty time, Dead Ball, illegal actions, Law 41 offences and sanctions, Law 42 offences & sanctions	Stage 1 & 2 together provide sufficient training for an independent league and regional junior cricket umpire

Stage 2 online (available soon)	£30.00	Over 5 weeks	As above delivered by a mixture of self-taught modules and 5 online tutor-led sessions	Stage 1 & 2 together provide sufficient training for an independent league and regional junior cricket umpire
U2A accreditation (optional)	£40 after Stage 2	In -season	Mentoring, online examination, match records, on-field assessments or boundary observations as directed by the County Development Officer (CDO), review of match portfolio	Accreditation an independent assessment of competence and may be taken into account when appointments to fixtures are made
Stage 3 face-to-face	£40 after U2A	2 days	Observation, Concentration, Points of focus, Mental strength, Game management including dealing with conflict, detailed limited overs analysis including interrupted match exercises, on-field record keeping, nutrition and hydration, self-reflection	Intended for umpires aspiring to Premier League officiating or beyond. Typically attended after a season or two of regular independent umpiring
U3A accreditation (optional)	£60 after Stage 3 but U2A must also have been completed	In-season	Mentoring, (harder) online examination, further match records, boundary observations as directed by the CDO, review of portfolio	Accreditation an independent assessment of competence and may be taken into account when appointments to fixtures are made
